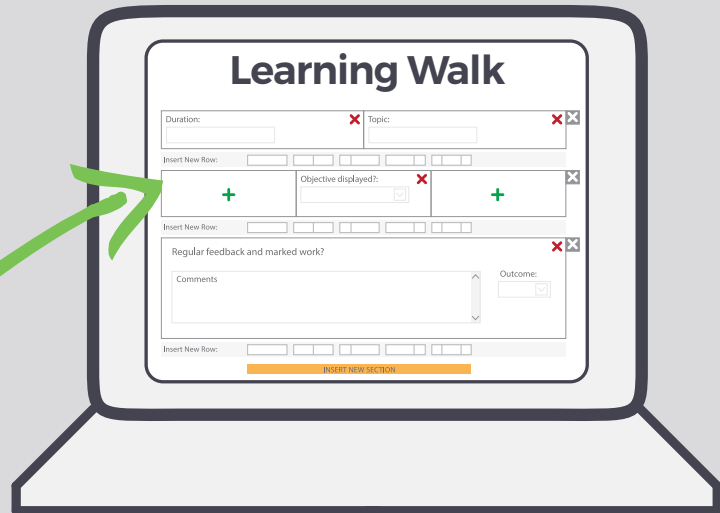
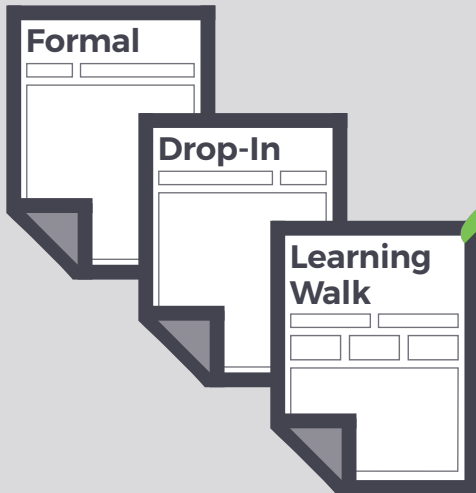
How does it work?

Observe is a **web-based service** which allows **evidence from lesson observations** (and more) to be **recorded using your mobile device, tablet or laptop**

Schools using Observe can **eliminate** paper and spreadsheets from the observation process, saving them up to an **hour** each time they observe, drop in or go on a learning walk



Create and customise electronic templates with your own fields and custom grading (you aren't limited to Ofsted's 1-4)



Record a variety of activities such as formal observations, learning walks and self-evaluation records

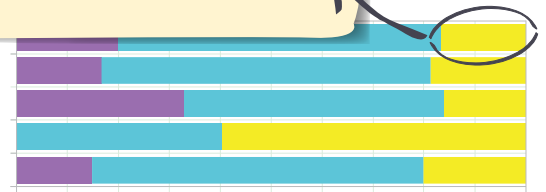


Observe teaching on mobile devices such as tablets and iPads, accessible from anywhere with an internet connection

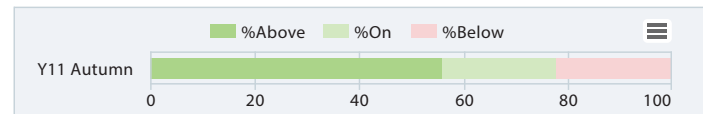
